








2024-2025 Uniform Policy

* We ask the cooperation of parents in ensuring compliance with these guidelines before a student arrives at school.

Uniform Item	Policies
<p>Shoes</p> 	<p><u>Every Uniform Day</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Solid colors only: white, brown, black, or navy blue - Only dress shoes, loafers, and tennis shoes - PE days: shoes may be a mixture of white, brown, black, and navy blue - Not allowed: <i>loose</i> slip ons, high tops, patterned Vans, Uggs, light-up shoes, boots, shoes with skate wheels - May have a small logo the same color as the shoe - Laces must match the main shoe color - Dress shoes are always preferred on Mass days. <i>*Please - no sneakers if serving at Mass.</i>

<p>Socks</p>	<p><u>Every Uniform Day</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Solid colors only: white, navy blue, black, or dark green - no logos allowed (unless same color) - Ankle bone must be covered - White, black, navy, or dark green tights (no leggings) are optional
<p>Girls' Skirts</p>	<p><u>Every Uniform Day</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - May not be more than 2" above the knee - Shorts must be worn under skirts- solid color (black, navy, or dark green) not visible when standing
<p>Pants/Shorts</p>	<p><u>Every Uniform Day</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Pants/Shorts may not be rolled <p><u>Mass Uniform Day</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Navy blue pants - <i>no shorts</i>

Note: Leggings are not a substitute for tights. Students wearing skirts/skorts on cold days must either wear tall socks or tights (white, black, dark green or navy blue) if they wish to have extra warmth.

<p>Shirts</p> <p><i>*Torn, frayed, severely stained shirts are not acceptable.</i></p>	<p><u>Every Uniform Day</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Must be buttoned and tucked in all day, every day except for during lunch and P.E. <p><u>Regular School Day</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - White or green SMA polo shirt - Optional sweater or vest (layering of non-uniform shirts in not allowed) <p><u>Mass Uniform Day</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - White SMA polo shirt (or blouse option for girls) with sweater or vest
<p>Jackets/Sweaters/ Sweatshirts/Cardigan</p> <p>Belts</p> <p>Hair / Grooming</p> <p>Miscellaneous</p>	<p><u>Regular School Day</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Heavier jackets or rain jackets may be worn to and from school only (in addition to the SMA jacket, sweatshirt, or 8th grade sweatshirt) in extreme weather. They must be removed while in the classroom. <p><u>Mass Uniform Day</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - SMA green cardigan, sweater, or 8th grade class sweatshirt (8th graders) <i>*Sweaters can be taken of it hot</i> <p><u>Every Uniform Day</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - All boys in grades 4-8 must wear a black belt - Hair may never be colored or dyed (including tinsel) - Boys hair may not touch the collar and must be above the eyebrows - Boys may not have facial hair - Fad haircuts (ex. mohawks, fades, and asymmetrical) are not allowed - Girls should have their hair pulled back away from eyes (accessories can be purchased from the Uniform Store) - <i>*neutral and school-colored girls' ponytail holders & headbands available at local stores are also possible choices</i> - Underwear/boxers/boxer briefs should never be visible when standing - Students may not have acrylic or fake nails - Girls using nail polish must use neutral or light colors - 7th & 8th Girls may wear light makeup - Girls may wear one (1) pair of earrings <1 inch drop and 1 necklace. No bracelets for safety reasons. - Avoid perfumes, colognes, and lotions to respect those with allergies/ asthma - Tattoos and / or writing on the skin are not permitted

Free/Relaxed Dress Days (birthdays, school events, school sports/games, ministry service, performances, etc.)

Shorts/skirts/dresses must be no higher than 2 inches above the knee.

Shoes must be secure, flat, and appropriate for PE and recess activities (sandals and high heels not allowed)

Shirts may not be strapless, off the shoulder, midriff, or tank tops.

Writing on shirts must be appropriate.

Hats may only be worn outdoors.

Refer to Uniform/Grooming guidelines above for hair, make-up and jewelry.
